

#### SPEAK UP! FIRST CHOICE CLINIC'S SPEAKER HAS A CALL TO ACTION

"You can take a bike, a car, a bus or a taxi to get an abortion, but it is fear that drives you," is how First Choice Clinic Annual Fundraising Banquet Speaker AnnMarie Cosgrove explained the struggles and challenges that came about because she made the choice to murder her baby.

The presentation she gave was an inspiration for those in attendance to think out of the box. Often, people wonder how someone could take the life of their baby. Cosgrove challenged us to think about what kind of fear forced that person to make that life-changing decision. Did they feel alone? Did they have support? Were they afraid of what their parents, boyfriend, their church would think of them? These were just a few questions that Cosgrove used to show the other side of abortion.



She challenged us to think about those that will never be parents or grandparents because of their decision. She gave us some insight into how that can change the complete direction of a life. The course of that destructive path changed for Cosgrove when she was touched by the love of Jesus through the death of her mother. Now she travels to encourage people to reach out and support those around them that may be going through an unplanned pregnancy or are carrying the burden of aborting a child. She suggested the audience be prepared to share contact information for a local pregnancy center by saving the phone number of First Choice Clinic, 651-267-4357, in their phones to give support to someone in time of need. She also asked them to also save the national Heartbeat International Options Helpline phone number, 1-800-712-4357 to use if they are not in the local area. She indicated being prepared is helpful when the Lord puts someone in your path who needs to know about a pregnancy resource center and their services. And when that happens, Speak Up!
