

LARGEST DIAPER DRIVE IN FIRST CHOICE CLINIC HISTORY

The diaper and baby bottle coin drive organized by Catholic Daughters of America Court Mazeppa Bellchester#1864 has become the largest diaper drive in the 19 year history of First Choice Clinic. Representatives from the organization delivered 8,279 diapers and 20 packages of wipes, along with blankets, clothing, and baby bottles full of change. "To say we were shocked, overwhelmed, and incredibly blessed is an understatement," said Sorenson. "Thank you to all!"
